Maintaining an inclusive environment in care and in general is very important. Having an awareness of gender identity and sexual diversity will support us in doing so, but ultimately respecting individual needs within our environment is our main goal.

In the latest Census, around **1.6 million** of the **44.9 million** people aged 16+ identified with an LGBT+ orientation

- **748,000** described themselves as gay or lesbian
- **624,000** described themselves as bisexual
- **165,000** selected “Other sexual orientation”
